Important details

Please read these important details that will help you make the best use of your time and have the best experience in Chicago.

- The Go Chicago Card is activated the first time the cardholder uses it for a free admission. Once activated, it is then valid for the number of consecutive calendar days the cardholder has purchased. (A 2-day card first used on a Monday is then valid Monday and Tuesday.)
- Admission must be redeemed the day a card is presented for entry. Admissions may not be redeemed at any attraction in return for a ticket to enter the attraction on a future date.
- Offers and admissions may be redeemed once per attraction per day unless otherwise noted.
- The Go Chicago Card is valid only at the attractions, shops, and restaurants listed in this guidebook or in any accompanying supplements.
- Attraction hours of operation are accurate at the time of printing but may change throughout the year. Please verify hours prior to visiting each attraction.
- Some attractions are seasonal (e.g. summer only), have varied hours/days of operation, or have special instructions for visiting with the Go Chicago Card (e.g. "go to information booth for entry"). Please refer to the attraction description for details.
- The Go Chicago Card offers are not valid in conjunction with any other offers or promotions.
- Special offers are valid for the duration of the card and do not activate the card unless otherwise noted. Please refer to the attraction page for details.
- The Go Chicago Card is non-transferable and non-refundable once activated.
- Attraction offerings are subject to change.
- Smart Destinations is not responsible for traffic conditions or weather that may affect a traveler's use of the Go Chicago Card.

Getting around Chicago

Chicago is a large but manageable city to navigate by walking, taxi and public transportation. Many of the city's top attractions are a short walk or ride away from each other.

Navigation tip: Picture Chicago as a vertical city on a map, with Lake Michigan as a natural border to the east. Chicago's numerical grid system is an easy reference point for directions. Every address is relative to the 0/0 mark at the intersection of State Street and Madison, and each 8 blocks equals 1 mile.

Walking & Biking

Chicago's lakefront boasts 26 uninterrupted miles of easy bike and walking trails. The attractions in this guidebook are organized by area so planning your sightseeing by walking routes is easy. If weather permits, consider renting a bicycle. Half-day rentals are available with your Go Chicago Card from Bike and Roll at Navy Pier and Millennium Park.

Public Transportation

The CTA (Chicago Transportation Authority) services the city of Chicago and 40 neighboring areas by rail and bus. Elevated trains, called the "L", service the downtown area in a circle called "The Loop". The 24-hour Blue Line connects the city to O'Hare airport, while the Orange Line runs to Midway airport.

Buses are an excellent way to get around the city. Stop by the Visitor Information Center on Michigan Avenue (across from Millennium Park) to pick up a map and schedule from a City Concierge or visit www.transitchicago.com/visitors.

Taxis

Taxis are abundant throughout most of Chicago and easy to hail. Taxi rates depend on gas prices and number of passengers.

Driving & Parking

Navigating the grid by car is easy but securing a parking spot can be difficult downtown. Consider looking for a parking garage but keep in mind hourly rates can be pricey.

Beyond Chicago

For trips outside of the city, consider a rental car or the Metra Rail that services nearby communities and suburbs of Chicago.
