## Important Information about SeaWorld® San Diego (Page 9)

- We are pleased to offer SeaWorld exclusively on 3, 4, 5, or 7-day cards.
- You may visit SeaWorld on each day that your 3, 4, 5, or 7-day card is valid.
- Proceed to the ticketing pavilion to the left of the main entry upon arrival to redeem your cards and receive tickets before entering the main gates/turnstiles. (Note - If you have a printed digital QR code or smart phone pass, you may skip the ticket booths and proceed direct to the main gates/turnstiles).
- Expired cards will not be valid for entry.
- 1 and 2-day cards do not include SeaWorld.
- Entry to SeaWorld must occur before 5:30 pm but once in the park you are welcome to stay until closing.
- Both your Go San Diego Card and SeaWorld Tickets are non-transferable, meaning once you activate them, you are the only person that can use the pass for the duration of the card.
- Please be prepared to show an ID that matches the signature on your card.

## Important details

Please read these important details that will help you make the best use of your time and have the best experience in San Diego.

- The Go San Diego Card is activated the first time the cardholder uses it for a free admission / entry. Once activated it is then valid for the number of consecutive calendar days the cardholder has purchased. (A 2-day card first used on a Monday is then valid Monday and Tuesday.)
- Admission must be redeemed the day a card is presented for entry. Admissions may not be redeemed at any attraction in return for a ticket to enter the attraction on a future date.
- Offers and admissions may be redeemed once per venue per day unless otherwise noted.
- Some attractions are seasonal (e.g. summer only), have varied hours/days of operation, or have special instructions for visiting with the Go San Diego Card (e.g. "go to information booth for entry"). Please refer to the attraction description for details.
- Attraction hours of operation are accurate at the time of printing but may change throughout the year. Please verify hours prior to visiting each attraction.
- The Go San Diego Card is valid only at the attractions, shops, and restaurants listed in this guidebook or in any accompanying supplements.
- The Go San Diego Card offers are not valid in conjunction with any other offers or promotions.
- Special offers are valid for the duration of the card and do not activate the card unless otherwise noted. Please refer to the attraction page for details.
- The Go San Diego Card is non-transferable and non-refundable once activated.
- \* Smart Destinations is not responsible for traffic conditions or weather that may affect a traveler's use of the Go San Diego Card.

# Getting around San Diego

San Diego is large and spread out but with multiple options for navigating the city getting around is easy. The public transport system is convenient and affordable but depending on where you stay and how far out of the city you plan to explore, you might find that the easiest option is to rent a car or hail a taxi.

## Getting Around on Public Transportation

San Diego and its surrounding areas have accessible and affordable public transit systems that include trolleys, buses, trains, and shuttles.

**Within San Diego:** The trolleys provide services from key locations in the downtown area while buses are great for navigating San Diego beyond downtown. The Big Bay Shuttle runs seasonally (between Memorial and Labor Day) and provides hop-on hop-off service along San Diego's Embarcadero with an all-day pass.

**Beyond San Diego:** The Amtrak California trains run to areas beyond San Diego. The Pacific Surfliner travels along the ocean with daily service to cities north of San Diego including Anaheim, Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, and San Luis Obispo while the Sprinter rail travels east out to Escondido.

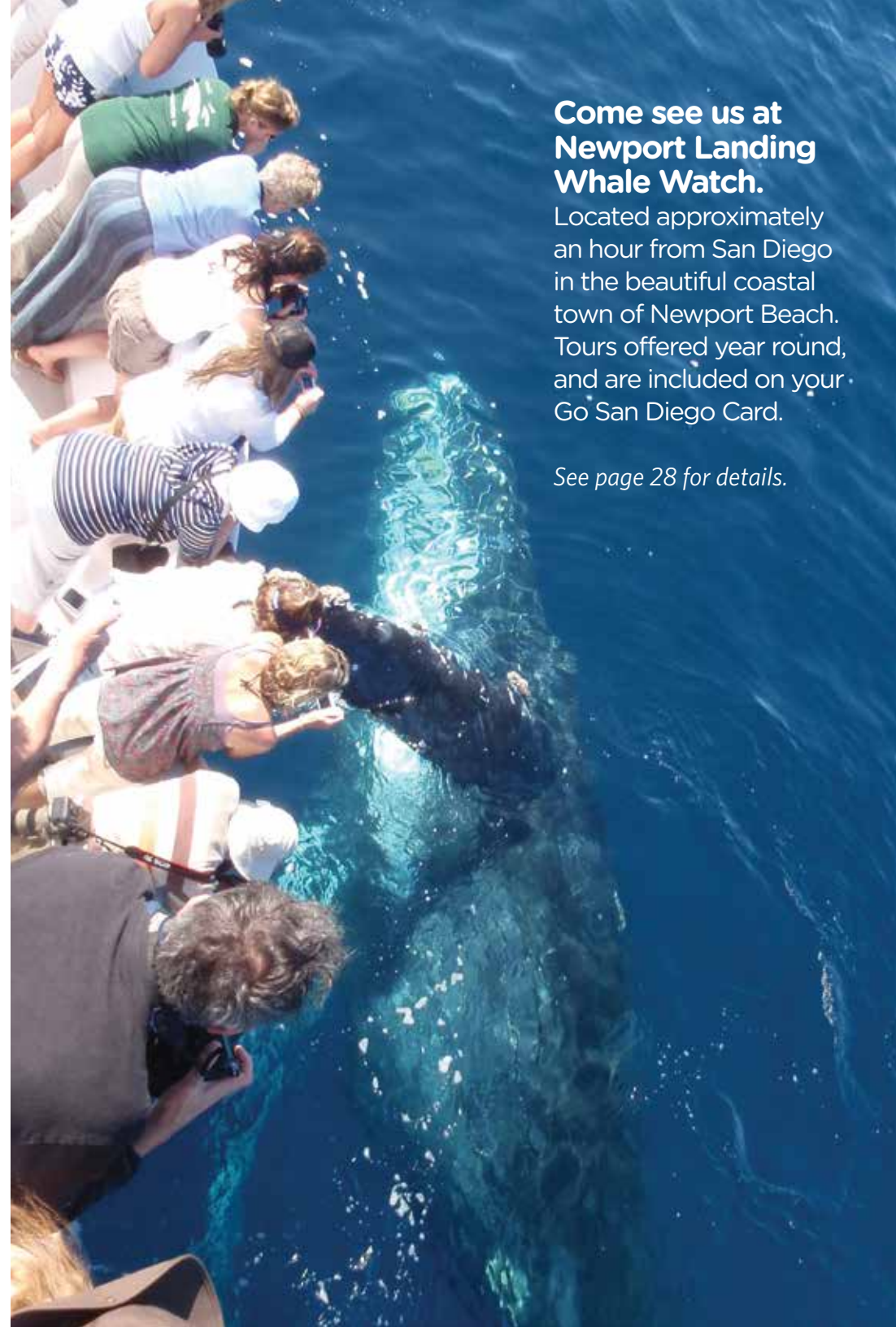
## Getting Around by Taxi or Car

**Taxi:** Taxis are widely available in San Diego but can be expensive if used as a main means of getting around the city.

**Car:** If you plan to visit attractions outside of downtown San Diego, renting a car is the most convenient option. Be sure to leave time to find parking downtown and account for parking fare at select attractions.

# Bonus Attractions

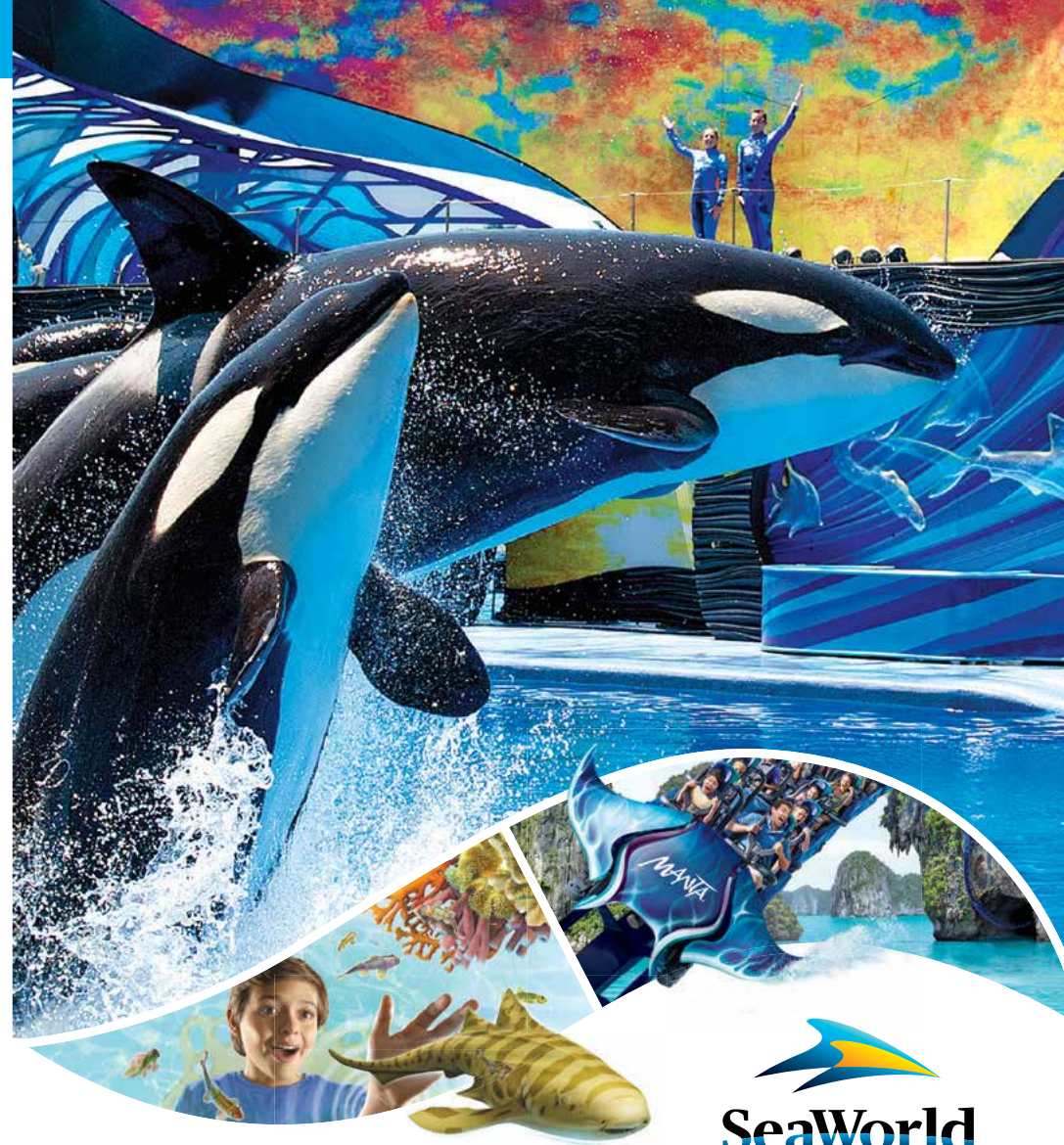
